The 1980's and 1990's were a period of significant growth in the areas of research and development in Southeast Michigan. Facilities evolved from strictly industrial or office uses into a combination of office, research, and light industrial parks.

The primary challenge was to position these parks so that they were close enough to support the businesses/clients that they interacted with yet also close to the residential developments where the workers lived. Additional challenges were to size the utility and drainage facilities to support these complexes before knowing precisely the size or use of the facilities to be placed.
