Giffels Webster was part of the team awarded a design/build dining hall contract by the U. S. Army Corp of Engineers. Three dining halls have completed to date: Ford Leonard, Fort Sill and Fort Leavenworth. Giffels Webster supplied civil engineering, surveying, and landscape architecture services for each. All have been designed to achieve LEED Silver rating.

The dining hall at Fort Sill, Oklahoma consisted of the construction of a new 26,462-square-foot dining facility and loading dock area to support the relocation of the 31st BDE Air Defense Artillery that was relocated from Fort Bliss, Texas. The 1300-person per meal dining facility has 624 seats and was co-located with several other new facilities.

Coordination was necessary to ensure that all the facilities would come together to support the relocation to Fort Sill. The civil engineering portion of project included site utilities (gas, water, sanitary sewer, and storm drainage), site grading, loading dock and ramp detailing, and coordination with adjacent projects.
